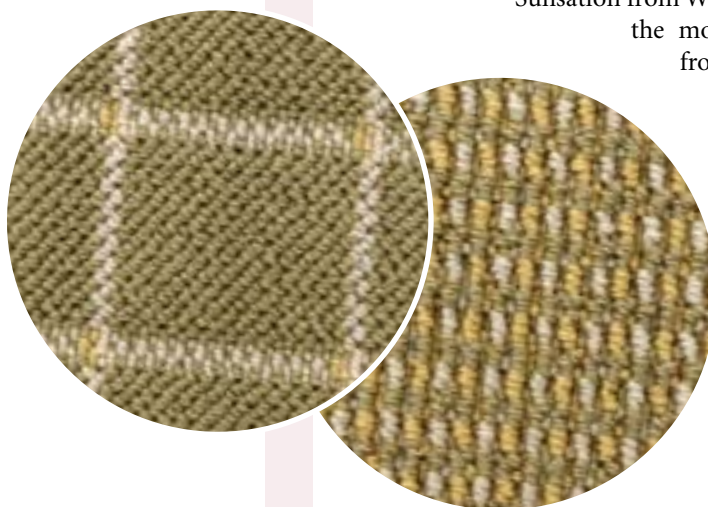
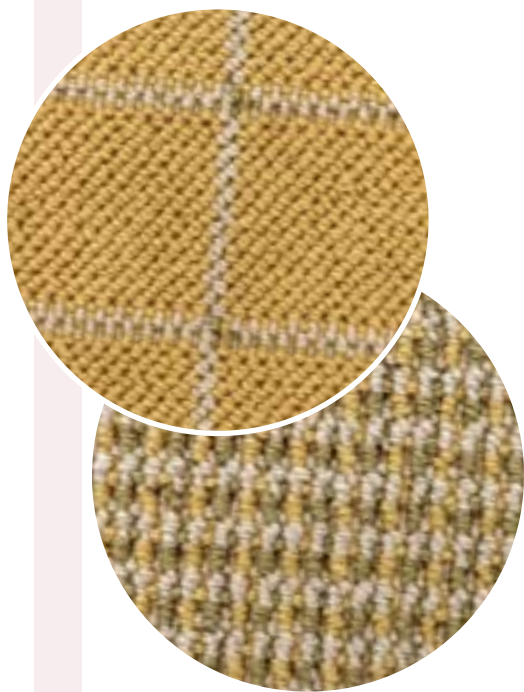

Actually, they're part of an all-wool collection called the Jack Mishkin Signature Collection by J. Mish.

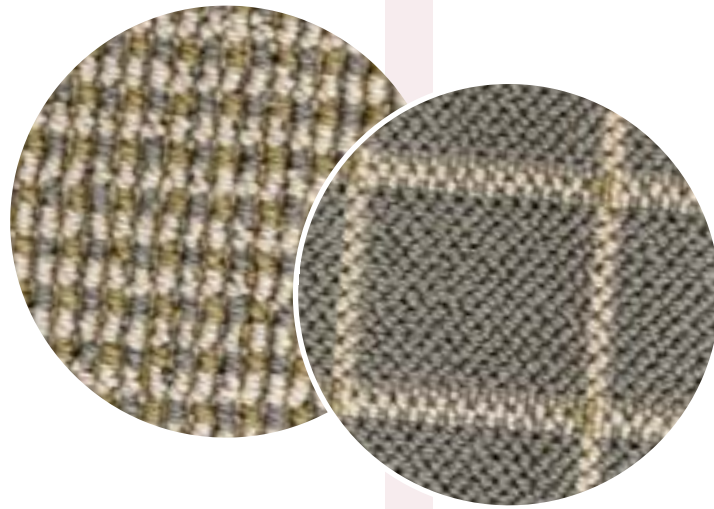

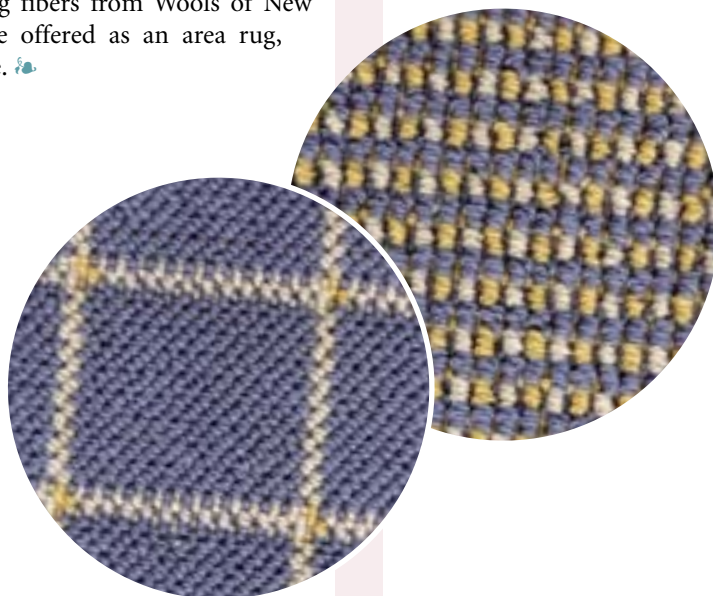
